## Are you a Pregnant Woman Who Currently Smokes?

Researchers at the University of Kentucky invite you to take part in a research study for pregnant women who currently smoke. - are currently pregnant
- can read, write, and speak English
- currently smoke cigarettes with no interest in quitting
- have less than an Associate's degree
