Why should I donate?

Having biological samples to use in their studies helps researchers do their work. This will allow researchers to discover more about neurologic conditions and may also contribute to the development of disease markers and more effective therapies.

What happens if I decide to participate?

If you choose to participate, you'll be asked to sign a consent form and NeuroBank staff will arrange the collection of your sample. If you later decide you don't want to participate, you can contact us and withdraw at any time.

What happens if you do not want to join the study?

Participation is voluntary and if a patient chooses not to participate, they will be treated no differently.
