HAVE YOU JUST HAD A HEART ATTACK?



You may be able to take part in the EMPACT-MI study.

WHO can participate?

- Men and women ages 18 and older
- Heart attack within the past 14 days of hospital admission
- At least one additional risk factor: (see your doctor for other factors that may qualify)
 - Age ≥ 65 years
 - Prior heart attack
 - Type 2 diabetes mellitus (no Type I)

WHAT can you expect?

- Study duration: 12 to 24 months
 - Includes 1-2 on-site visits and 3-6 remote visits
 - Option to use telephone, mobile app, or computer for remote visits
- Study medication is taken by mouth once per day with water, with or without food.
- You will continue to receive your regular health care while on the study.
- You will be placed by chance into the study drug or placebo group. A placebo looks like study drug but has no medicine in it.
- Study-related care, tests, and study medication will be provided to participants at no cost.
