Researchers at the University of Kentucky are conducting a study to develop and refine a home-based music and movement program for people living with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. We are inviting individuals with lived or professional experience with dementia to join a remote Community Advisory Board (CAB). Members will try the program, share feedback on participant-facing materials, and help shape how the program and study are implemented.

- Send feedback by email.
- Help shape how researchers talk about the study and share results.

You may be eligible to participate if you are over 18 years old and:

- live in the U.S.
- speak and read English or Spanish
- can engage in online meetings (with video-on)
- have personal experience with Alzheimer's or Dementia caregiving
